<p>Currently AMiRo-LLD drivers are activated via the alldconf.h file, which results in numerous files being compiled without providing any functionality. Furthermore, those useless files will be included in the QtCreator projects, since GCC evaluates them. To tackle this issue, drivers should be enabled via the module Makefile, so only the required files and paths are included to the build process. The alldconf.h file can still be used to configure the drivers if they provide further settings.</p>
